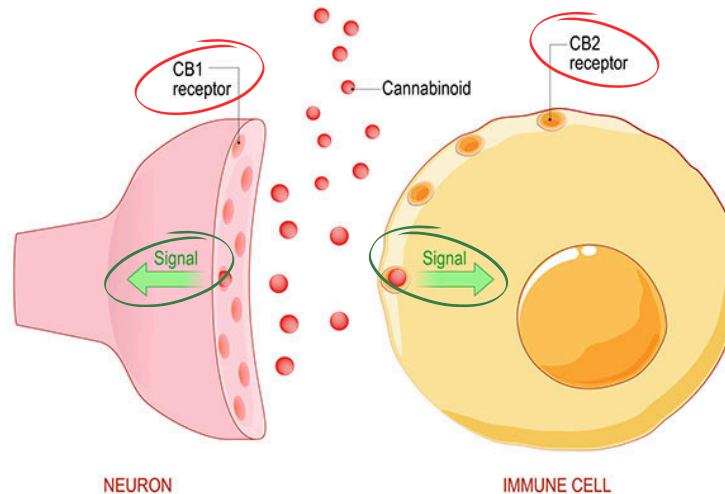

The endocannabinoid system: Essential and mysterious

The Endocannabinoid System (ECS) is a Two-Way System: THC ▶ CB1 receptors to CBD ▶ CB2 receptors!

"The ECS regulates and controls many of our most critical bodily functions such as learning and memory, emotional processing, sleep, temperature control, pain control, inflammatory and immune responses, and eating. ... We know that the ECS plays a critical role in learning and memory due to several lines of research."

The endocannabinoid system helps correct many different imbalances within the body via activated receptors found throughout our central and peripheral nervous systems, known as CB1 and CB2 receptor sites. The CB1 receptors are predominately found in the brain and spinal canal which have an affinity for interaction with the THC molecule. There are 6 times more CB2 receptors found throughout the body, predominately for the immune system, that interacts with the CBD molecule.

Over 100 different phytocannabinoids are found in hemp. Secondary metabolites include:

- Terpenes: give the plant its scent and help to enhance the effect of CBD
- Polyphenols: contain antioxidant properties and affect the flavor and color of the plant
- Flavonoids: contain antioxidant properties and affect the color of the plant

**Don't restrict hemp products to just two isolates: cannabidiol or cannabigerol!
For effective health benefits, we need the two-way system - not isolates.**

Since 2019, Texans have found relief from a variety of health conditions like pain, anxiety, sleep, inflammation, epilepsy, etc. **from various hemp products containing full spectrum CBD.** These are everyday Texans, school teachers, bank employees, city employees, moms, granddads, etc.

Millions of Texans have benefitted and possess millions of hemp products in their homes and businesses. Under Sec. 443.252 of SB 3, these people would be charged with a Class A Misdemeanor for Possession! Don't prosecute innocents!
